PRIMARY PROVISION

The Nest is our specialist offsite provision for KS1 and KS2 learners, offering a nurturing environment where a multidisciplinary team combines curriculum learning with SEMH support and therapeutic intervention.

POST 16

A flexible, practical route beyond school for young people aged 16+, building skills and qualifications for real next steps into work, training or further education.

KS4 VOCATIONAL PATHWAYS

A practical, hands-on alternative to the classroom for KS4 learners combining vocational skills with core academic lessons.

SPECIALIST OUTREACH

Meeting young people wherever they're at - at home, in the community or in school - to rebuild engagement, attendance and trust.

SCHOOL INCLUSION BASES

Bringing our trusted hub model directly onto the school site, School Inclusion Bases are led by the school and delivered by our experts, giving learners specialist support without leaving their school community.

OFF-SITE PRIMARY ALTERNATIVE PROVISION

The Nest is our specialist offsite provision for younger learners at KS1 and KS2 – a nurturing, purposefully designed environment for children who need a different approach to education.

Delivered by a skilled, multidisciplinary team, The Nest combines a broad and balanced curriculum with embedded SEMH support, therapeutic intervention and high staff ratios, giving younger learners the safety, consistency and relationships they need to re-engage, build confidence and progress. Placements are commissioned by local authorities and schools and are designed to support reintegration into mainstream education where this is the right next step for the child.

OFF-SITE SECONDARY ALTERNATIVE PROVISION

Traditional education isn't right for everyone. For some learners, gaining practical, hands-on experience in career-focused learning is far more motivating than the conventional academic route offered by mainstream education, they want skills that are vocation-focused, not just exam-focused.

As AI and automation reshape the workplace, many learners recognise that real, vocational experience is what will future-proof their careers and set them up for long-term employability. Our KS4 Vocational Pathways offer a purposeful alternative for learners aged 14-19 who thrive through practical, career-focused education - whether referred by their school or commissioned directly by a local authority for EOTAS learners. Core academic lessons continue alongside this vocational learning, and our accredited qualifications contribute to Progress 8 for schools and support measurable EHCP outcomes for LA-commissioned placements.

SPECIALIST OUTREACH

REBUILDING ENGAGEMENT AND ATTENDANCE

Specialist Outreach exists to reach the learners the system is losing - young people who are NEET, at risk of becoming NEET, or too disengaged from mainstream school to access the support they need. Our priority is simple: rebuild the relationship with education before anything else can follow.

We meet learners where they're at - literally. Our tutors work with each young person at home, in the community, in school, or wherever gives them the best chance of engaging, rather than asking them to fit around a fixed setting that hasn't worked for them before. Alongside this, we rebuild trust, addressing the anxiety, unmet needs and EBSA that have kept them away from the classroom, while structured academic lessons continue so learners keep progressing in core subjects rather than falling further behind.

The result is measurable: engagement and attendance restored, and a clear pathway back into mainstream education, training or employment.

MEETING THE NEED FOR POST-16 ALTERNATIVE PROVISION

Post-16 alternative provision remains one of the most underdeveloped areas of the education system. As the SEND Review continues to reshape the national landscape, Nulogic is responding ahead of the curve. Bringing the same specialist, therapeutically informed expertise that defines our school-age work into the Post-16 space.

Nulogic offer specialist Post-16 provision at our Coventry based sites, The Forge and The Workshop - a purposeful, vocational programme for young people aged 16-19 with SEND who are at risk of, or already experiencing, NEET.

As a registered provider, we can be named in Section I of a young person's EHCP. This means local authorities can commission us as a placement, not a short-term intervention, giving learners the continuity, stability and specialist support they need at one of the most critical transitions of their lives.

Industry-standard, hands-on training leading to a recognised vocational qualification. Learners leave with the practical skills and confidence to pursue employment, an apprenticeship or further training.

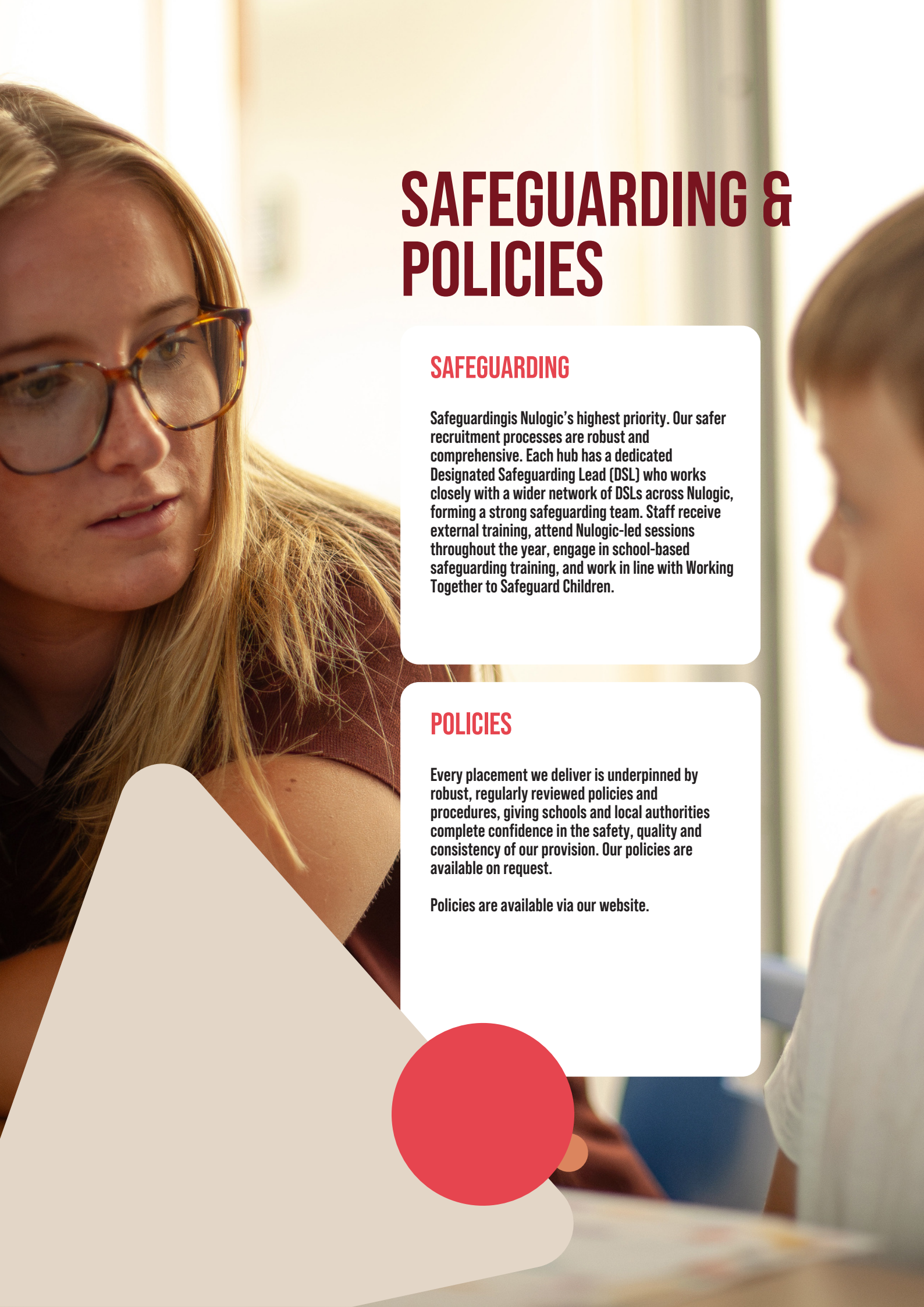
CONSTRUCTION

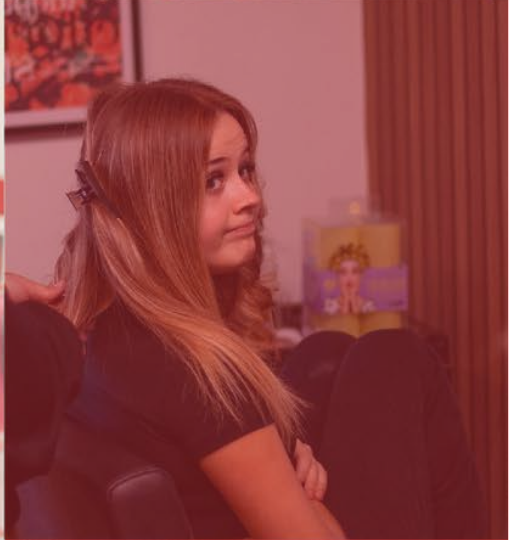
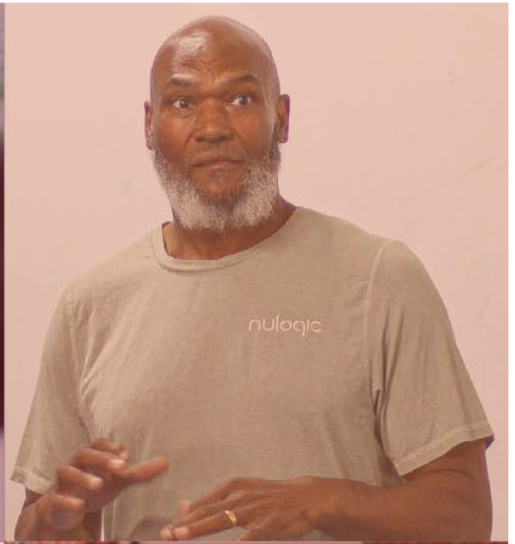
SAFEGUARDING

Safeguarding is Nulogic's highest priority. Our safer recruitment processes are robust and comprehensive. Each hub has a dedicated Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) who works closely with a wider network of DSLs across Nulogic, forming a strong safeguarding team. Staff receive external training, attend Nulogic-led sessions throughout the year, engage in school-based safeguarding training, and work in line with Working Together to Safeguard Children.
